WHAT DOES EVEN FINANCIAL, INC. & FIONA DO WITH YOUR PERSONAL INFORMATION?

Why?

Financial companies choose how they share your personal information. Federal law gives consumers the right to limit some but not all sharing. Federal law also requires us to tell you how we collect, share, and protect your personal information. Please read this notice carefully to understand what we do.

What?

The types of personal information we collect and share depend on the product or service you have with us. This information can include:

- Social Security number and income
- · account balances and payment history
- · credit history and credit scores

When you are *no longer* our customer, we continue to share your information as described in this notice.

How?

All financial companies need to share customers' personal information to run their everyday business. In the section below, we list the reasons financial companies can share their customers' personal information; the reasons Even Financial, Inc. chooses to share; and whether you can limit this sharing.

What we do	
How does Even Financial, Inc. protect my personal information?	To protect your personal information from unauthorized access and use, we use security measures that comply with federal law. These measures include computer safeguards and secured files and buildings.
How does Even Financial, Inc. collect my personal information?	 We collect your personal information, for example, when you Give us your contact information or open an account or Apply for aloan We also collect your personal information from others, such as credit bureaus affiliates, or other companies.
Why can't I limit all sharing?	 sharing for affiliates' everyday business purposes—information about your creditworthiness affiliates from using your information to market to you sharing for nonaffiliates to market toyou State laws and individual companies may give you additional rights to limit sharing. Definitions	
Affiliates	Companies related by common ownership or control. They can be financial an nonfinancial companies. Our affiliates include companies with a Even Financial, Inc. name, [and financial companies such as] Fiona, LeapLife and Birch Finance
Nonaffiliates	Companies not related by common ownership or control. They can be financial and nonfinancial companies. • Non-affiliated companies we share with include financial services companies such as our lender partners and other service providers (i.e., those companies that are a necessary part of the product or service you are requesting), and certain marketing partners
Joint marketing	A formal agreement between nonaffiliated financial companies that together market financial products or services to you. Our joint marketing partners include for example credit card, loan companies and other types of marketing partners.

Other important information

For California residents: We will not share information we collect about you with nonaffiliated third parties, except as permitted by law, including, for example with your consent or to service your account. We will limit sharing with our affiliates to the extent required by California law.

For Vermont residents: We will not share information we collect about you with nonaffiliated third parties, except as permitted by law, including, for example with your consent or to service your account. We will not share information about your creditworthiness with our affiliates other than as permitted by Vermont law, unless you authorize us to make those disclosures.
